LEADING BY EXAMPLE (LbE)

Engagement of Turkish Cypriot and Greek Cypriot Business Leaders in Dialogue, Cooperation and Reconciliation

A project co-funded by the European Union under the "Cypriot Civil Society in Action IV" programme, jointly implemented by the Turkish Cypriot Chamber of Commerce (KTTO) and the Cyprus Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCCI).

Duration: 1st July 2014 – 30th June 2016 (24 months)

Main Objective:

Contribute to the dialogue, trust, cooperation, and reconciliation between civil societies, including the business communities, throughout Cyprus, and to increase the involvement of Cyprus civil society in decision making processes at the political level.

We are building trust and working for reconciliation in Cyprus through:

"Island-wide Telecoms" initiative to interoperate mobile telephony in the whole island. LbE project will facilitate meetings of mobile operators from both communities, as well as promote this new service once available.

- "Park for Cooperation" initiative to create a common outdoor space within the Ledra Buffer Zone for bazaar-style and cultural bi-communal events.
- Sectoral business meetings involving various sectors of the economy in both communities.
- Engaging business leaders and politicians for the post-settlement economy in Cyprus.
- "Nicosia Ring Tour" initiative financing the compiling of a techno-economic feasibility study for a hop-on/ hop-off bus service travelling around Nicosia in both communities. This study will be offered to the Nicosia Municipalities for implementation.
- "Cross-community internship programme" benefiting at least 24 young unemployed graduates, aged 20-35 years old, interested to acquire work experience in the other community relevant to their skills and interests, over a period of 3 months and a monthly allowance of €500.
- Workshops and Discussions involving the Cypriot civil society in various themes such as Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR), Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), Social Entrepreneurship, etc.
- Presentations of Films and Books by Cypriot producers/authors which promote the overall objective of the LbE project.
- Panel debates at universities engaging young entrepreneurs from both communities.
